

Membership Grades



The Chartered
Institute of Logistics
and Transport

Your membership grade reflects your professional qualifications, expertise and experience - make sure your commitment to the industry is rewarded with the grade you deserve.

■ AFFILIATE

Affiliate membership offers access to most membership benefits. This grade is open to those who are interested in logistics and transport but who, at the moment, may not qualify for, or aspire to a higher grade of membership.

■ MEMBER (MILT)

CRITERIA:

Candidates for election or upgrading to the grade of Member hold an approved qualification at level 3 or 4 in logistics or transport and have management responsibility.

Relevant N/SVQs at Level 3 or the CILT Certificate and at least 3 years experience in logistics or transport.

or

Relevant N/SVQs at Level 4 (or above) or the

CILT Professional Diploma and at least 2 years experience in logistics or transport.

The Professional Entry: If you do not hold a relevant qualification at Level 3 or above but have 5 years experience (including 3 years at junior management level), you may submit a portfolio of evidence for consideration under the **Accreditation of Prior Achievement (APA)** process to demonstrate that you meet the Institute's criteria.

All applications should be supported with a detailed CV, an application form and 2 year CPD plan.

■ CHARTERED MEMBER (CMILT)

CRITERIA:

An exempting qualification (usually an approved degree and 5 years experience in logistics or transport (including 2 years at senior level), or the CILT Advanced Diploma or a relevant Level 6 qualification and 5 years experience in logistics or transport (including 2 years at senior level).

or

A non-accredited degree and at least 7 years experience in logistics or transport including 3 years at senior level.

The Professional Entry: This route enables experienced logistics or transport professionals, who do not meet the standard academic requirements for Chartered Membership but have 7 years experience in logistics or transport (including 2 years at senior level), you may submit a portfolio of evidence to demonstrate that you meet the Institute's criteria.

All applications should be supported with a detailed CV, an application form and 2 year CPD plan.

■ CHARTERED FELLOW (FCILT)

CRITERIA:

You should meet the criteria for Chartered Membership and have at least 7 years experience in a high responsibility position(s) in the management of logistics or transport. Fellow is also granted to people who have attained a position of eminence in logistics and/or transport.

All applications should be supported with a detailed CV, application form and 2 year CPD plan.
