



2016 GOVERNING COUNCIL ELECTION RULES

1. Any member of The Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport (CILT) may attend the EGM to witness the elections.
2. Only Institute members may vote. Per the CILT constitution, ‘‘Institute Members’’ constitute the following membership categories or grades: Chartered Members and Chartered Fellows.
3. A person who nominates or seconds a nomination must be a fully paid up Chartered Member or Chartered Fellow at both sectional and national levels of CILT Ghana.
4. No Chartered Member or Chartered Fellow shall be nominated unless that member is a fully paid up member at both the Sectional and National levels. Any nominee who has not fully paid up shall be disqualified.
5. A Chartered Member or Chartered Fellow shall nominate not more than two candidates provided the two are not for the same position. It is therefore important that nominees ensure the Chartered Member or Chartered Fellow who nominates them has not done so for another nominee seeking the same position. Failure to do so will result in the disqualification of all nominees proposed by the said Chartered Member or Chartered Fellow.
6. All Section Chairmen shall send a list of fully paid up members to the Executive Secretary not later than **26th October 2016**.
7. The Executive Secretary shall submit the full list of Chartered Members or Chartered Fellows showing their status to the Chairperson, Elections Committee not later than **31st October 2016**.
8. All nominations must be submitted in hardcopy (fully endorsed by nominee, nominator, and endorser); which must reach the Chairperson of the Elections Committee (Dr. Mrs. Doreen Owusu-Fianko) not later than **31st October 2016** at **1700hrs UTC**. Late submission shall not be accepted.
9. A winner shall be declared by a simple majority of votes cast
10. If there is a tie, there shall be another vote until a winner emerges.
11. Recounting of votes will not be allowed unless there is a palpable evidence of an anomaly in counting
